
As the weather starts to warm, the island takes on a more laid back pace.

Getting Around Key West

Now that you're in Key West, you probably don't need a car. Parking is challenging and expensive. After a night of drinking on Duval, you definitely don't want to drive anything. Even riding a bicycle while intoxicated will get you a DUI.

If you are lucky enough to be staying in old town, walking is your best bet.

For short trips, try a pedicab. They are a unique way to get around and your partner will give you bonus points for the romantic ride home.

Taxis are just a phone call away and arrive within minutes. Any bartender will call one for you.

Scooters and bicycles are inexpensive to rent and can be a fun way to see the island. Please ask for proper training and information about local laws. 





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Your Angie was good-naturedly warned: "Bob Oberle's a nice enough guy, but quiet. I don't know what you plan to ask, but good luck."

Of course, I've encountered the stony-silence of a Duval-based Bob before -- he of the rock-hard ass in Kwest.

Surely if I could chisel into his dry demeanor, I could penetrate Bob, the new General Manager of Bourbon St. Pub / New Orleans House / Bootleggers. In a town of inconsistency, his ongoing presence there dates back to 1999, with incremental promotions from bartender to Bar Manager to Assistant General Manager only a year ago.

Still, I bring pliers, open acknowledgement that I'd been told our interview would be like pulling teeth.

So here's what flopped my milkjugs over my shoulderpads: Bob ("I don't do Robert") Oberle II not only speaks, he mocks, rebuts, grins and debates. We directly dissect and dispel this humorless public perception.

Why do people think you're unfriendly and laugh-free?

It was definitely busier five years ago, but it's always gone up and down. I'd personally like to see a return to old days of The Copa, and we can do a better job of marketing to Miami and Fort Lauderdale as an alternative, yet close, getaway destination. Bourbon St. Pub is initiating a Garden Bar Sunday afternoon Tea Dance, and Bootleggers is evolving. Wednesday will be for women -- beer, pool and darts -- and from Thursday through Saturday night, it will a XXXX backroom atmosphere, with darkness, dancers and champagne.

I just believe Key West is due for a turnaround soon.

Of things turning around and about, your and David's drag performance at the Bourbon annual Turnabout is always a thing to behold.

And I'm glad it's only once a year. I hate doing drag. But it's like our Underwear theme night (next chance to cavort in your drawers is May 26th) -- I can't expect someone to do it when I don't. I pick the song, choreograph -- anyone who knows me understands what I mean when I say boxstop!!! -- and David shows up. He always worries he's going to fuck up.

So, 6 years later, if not here, where would you and David be?
