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

She may very well have a lot of questions, fears, misunderstandings about what it means to be gay and what it means for her to have a gay brother, Especially since the rest of your family took the news so well, she could easily feel frightened to ask these questions out of not wanting to seem homophobic or unsupportive. Remember, this woman has been with you since you were born and now you are telling her that there is this whole other part to your life that she was never privy to. That is a shock, my dear! You need to be there for her the way you want her to be there for you. Maybe she will rise to the challenge, maybe she will walk away. But at the very least you both will have it out in the open and there will be no big question marks as to where you both stand on the matter.

I would love to tell you that the ends result of all this will be that you will both get to a place of understanding and love again. But that may not be the case. She may truly have problems with your sexuality that cannot be worked through. In that case, you will have to decide what is best for you and your well being. I pray to God, you two can get back to a place of closeness. It would be a shame for her to let all that love go just because of this little part of who you are. And it would be a shame for you to lose a sister just because you're both scared to open up and put it all on the table. Please write me back and let me know how things go. And tell your sister she can always write me too!

It is in moments like this that even a silly clown such as I sees God, even if just for a minute. And it is moments like this that remind me why our little communities are so very important. They are living, breathing proof that we ARE a community. We ARE a family.

Now that summer is coming to a close here in the North, I will shortly be planning my virgin journey to Key West sometime this winter! People are beginning to realize that when you say "I want a commitment", you really mean "I'm tired of masturbating."


