### Key-West Beaches


Key West is basically one giant rock so the beaches are not the best you will find. However, sand is trucked in to make for a beautiful sandy beach.







If you are lucky enough to be staying in old town, walking is your best bet.


For short trips, try a pedicab. They are a unique way to get around and your partner will give you bonus points for the romantic ride home.
