



I found out a few days before leaving that RV was already down there performing and that we'd be there together for my whole run in Mexico. Well, from the second I got off the plane and was headed for a cab I heard, through the crowd of aggressive, carmel-colored cab drivers, the dulcet tones of "HOOKER!" being shouted in English over the tops of all their little jet black heads. It was RV, well... Timothy, in this instance, I began to laugh my ass off and didn't stop laughing for the entire 2 weeks I was there. Our clubs were two blocks away from each other so we'd meet after our shows at this tiny little martini bar called Apaches. I'd get drunk, she'd get stoned... and we'd sit with Andre (a cross-eyed Dutch lesbian bartender) and pick up boys. He would walk the beach, in drag, during the days to promote his show. Though Puerto Vallarta is considered to be the gay capitol of Mexico... they still hadn't seen anything like RV. He even entered the theater one night... on a fucking donkey! It was brilliant. He was brilliant.

I remember one night, about halfway through my time there, we had the most amazing dinner. There is this restaurant on Los Muertos beach that, in the evening, will set a table up for you to dine at, down by the ocean's side. But then he dropped the topic and moved on to happier topics.

I wish now that I had forced him to go to some crappy Mexican doctor the next morning. Hell, I wish I'd held the fucker down and just cut off his damn leg to spite his face. I'm sure he would have forgiven me in time... I mean, think of the "Pirates of the Caribbean" numbers he could have done! Not to mention, what would be more brilliant that a peg-legged RV Beaumont waddling up and down Duvel?! But I didn't. I finished my meal and many meals with him those two weeks. We spent Christmas Eve and Christmas Day together. We took sunset walks and sunrise walks and late night walks. We saw each other's shows way too much, and still laughed for each other every time. By the end of those two weeks, we had probably fit in 6 years worth of memories into those 14 days. You can't do that with a lot of people. It takes a special kind of person. It takes an RV to fit all those experiences into such a small space and time. I am a better person for having known Timothy Swain. I am a better comedian for having known RV Beaumont. And I feel sorry for all the people left in the world who never got the privilege to know either... let alone both.

As I write this, I am only a few days away from returning to Puerto Vallarta. This time, performing for Atlantis Events at a swank resort. And I'm sure I'll have a wonderful time... as I always do with Atlantis. But I think one night, while all the boys are dancing and drinking, I might just sneak away to the other side of town. And I'll order two shots at Apaches, and I'll smoke up a little out back with Andre... and then I'll walk down to a little restaurant on a quiet stretch of sand. And I'll ask for a table for two down by the water. And I'll order Chile Relleno. And I'll have dinner with a friend one more time...
